Dear Maria,

I have given you a month to reflect on what I have told you. Your response put you in a less than favorable light considering what I told you, which included my suspicions that you had known about this for a very long time. Immediately trying to control the situation, suppress the truth and continue to enable your husband's activities is not the actions of someone who didn't know. I have known for a very long time how you feel about me based on your actions and my emails are not being sent to change your mind. I am simply trying to make sure that my sisters and nephew are protected. My actions have shown this isn't about money as I have already been threatened if I pursue this and my actions are telling you my true feelings. This has to be fixed and addressed properly.

In a sense, you have a chance to get everything you want but I must be satisfied Todd is under control and makes amends for his behavior or I will have no other choice but to continue this. I have been praying every day for a resolution to this problem since it started and specifically to get the family through this crisis with a healthy resolution. What I have asked you to do is join me in helping fix this situation but your actions have shown you to be steadfast in your refusal.

I know you consider yourself a good Christian and I am appealing to that person to help me fix this situation instead of continuing to enable it. You have told me you love not only me but your daughters and I refer you to Exodus 34:6-7. I ask you to talk to Pastor Landon about this situation. While I know you don't love me, I want you to think of Lisa and Madison when you read this passage. I am going to see this through Maria and I am not expendable like so many of the other women in your husband's has used before me. I know a lot of time and preparation went into this and when it was just about money the gamble paid off and I walked. The situation has changed now and I am going to fix this no matter what the cost to me personally.

PLEASE talk to Pastor Landon and let him mediate a call between us to try and figure this out. Please read the above referenced passage and think about the effect that this had on the entire family. Banishing me from the family for exposing a horrifying situation in order to fix it, is the opposite of being a good Christian and you are actually hurting your daughters by doing it.

The reason I am trying to fix this with you is I this knowledge is something that no child should live with, no matter how old they are. In short, I am asking you to do the right thing and reflect on this in church tomorrow and pray.
